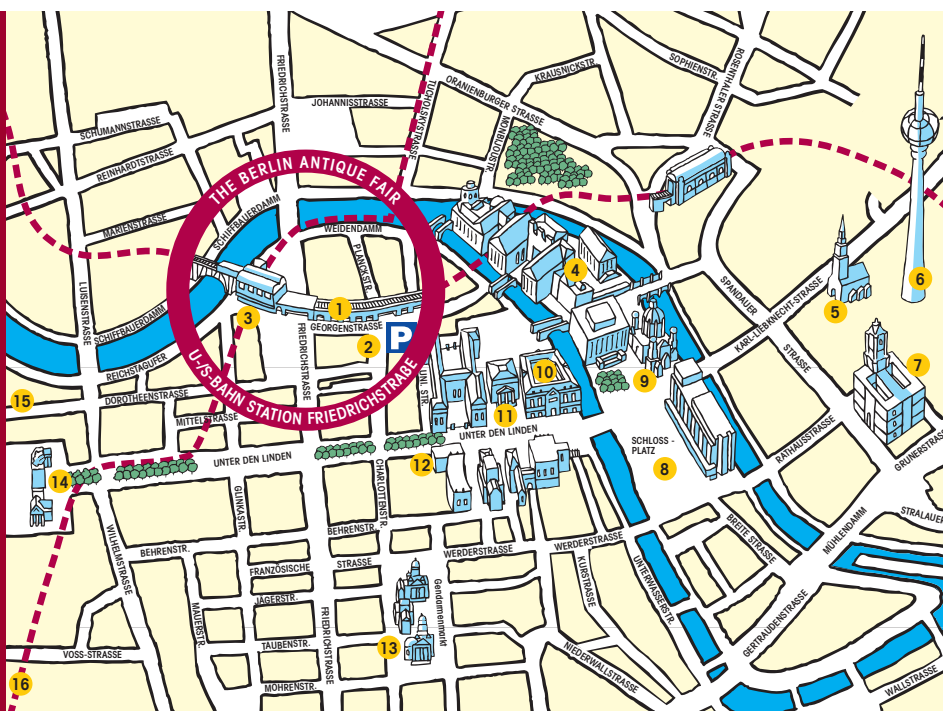
amidst this fine selection of merchandise. You just have to know where to look.
